

WHERE WILL YOU BE IN 1,000 YEARS?

You have a choice: Heaven or Hell

The Bible says no one goes to Heaven unless they are **“Born Again.”** Only by believing that Jesus Christ died for your sins and was raised from the dead, can you be saved. God is one: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. No one comes to the Father, except through the Son, Jesus Christ. There is no other way. Eternal damnation and total separation from God is your choice. God, I am a sinner and need a Savior. Lord Jesus, I believe You are the Savior of the world who died for my sins and took my punishment. I believe You are God and were raised from the dead. Please come into my heart. I am sorry for my sins and turn from them. Thank you for saving me, forgiving me and making me a new creation! Thank you for taking me to Heaven when I die! In the name of my Lord Jesus. AMEN!

If you sincerely prayed this prayer, a spiritual transaction has just occurred. According to the Bible, you are now **“Born-Again,” “Saved,” “Redeemed,” “Sanctified,”** and **“Washed in the Blood.”** You have now experienced the **“New Birth”** and **“Regeneration.”** The Bible says nothing can take you out of the hand of Jesus Christ. You are His child and He is your God forever! Your life is about to change in wonderful ways!

WHAT'S NEXT?

You will now experience a new hunger for God, the Bible and true worship. Love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control will be experienced by you. This is called the **“Fruit of the Spirit”** (Galatians 5:22).
