

“TWELVE STONES”

So when the people broke camp to cross the Jordan River, the priest carrying the Ark of the Covenant went ahead of them. Now the Jordan is at flood stage all during the harvest. Yet as soon as the priests who carried the Ark reached the Jordan and their feet touched the water's edge, the water from upstream stopped flowing. It piled up in a heap a great distance away... So the people crossed over opposite Jericho. The priests who carried the Ark of the Covenant of the LORD stood firm on dry ground in the middle of the Jordan while all Israel passed by until the whole nation had completed the crossing on dry ground.

When the whole nation had finished crossing the Jordan, the LORD said to Joshua, “Choose twelve men from among the people, one from each tribe, and tell them to take up twelve stones from the middle of the Jordan, from right where the priests stood, and carry them over with you and put them down at the place you will stay tonight... In the future, when your children ask you, “What do these stones mean?” tell them that the flow of the Jordan was cut off before the Ark of the Covenant of the LORD... These stones are to be a memorial to the people of Israel forever.

JOSHUA 3 & 4

On December 9, 2001 God used a stranger, Dr. Mahesh Chavda, to speak a prophetic Word over artist/evangelist Max Greiner, Jr. and his wife, Sherry, at CATHEDRAL OF PRAISE church in Austin, TX. In front of the entire congregation, Dr. Chavda from North Carolina prophesied to the Greiners that they would be involved in “restoring the Tabernacle” and that God would use the Christ-honoring sculptures Max had created in his life to decorate this last days’ Tabernacle (Amos 9:11 & Isaiah 2:2).

Then on August 22, 2002 another stranger, Marlon Quibodeaux, emailed the artist saying God was calling him to create a 77’7” Resurrection cross over IH-10. Confused by the strange prophetic Word, Max prayed and received a vision of a giant hollow empty cross and a 300’ long cross shaped garden with the Gospel on tiles in multiple languages. This garden is a “type” of New Testament Tabernacle. The 300’ garden represents the Inner Court of the Tabernacle and “The Empty Cross” represents the Holy of Holies, the Ark of the Covenant.

In September of 2010, God spoke to TCKF Trustee, Barbara Sullivan, telling her that a symbolic JORDAN RIVER CROSSING should be created at the entrance of the garden property. The LORD said to honor the first 12 major donors with 12 stones from the river, who made it possible for the people to enter the Promised Land. On July 19, 2012 the main entrance road was opened to the public. 144 Christians from across Texas and Arizona symbolically crossed the Jordan River on dry ground as local pastors and worshippers led the procession up the 1930’ hill to the 77’7” cross.
