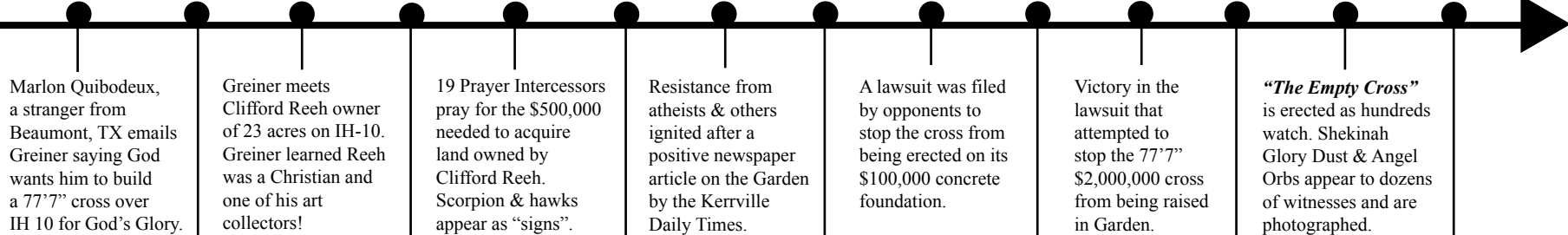

Birth of the "Vision"



Marlon Quibodeux, a stranger from Beaumont, TX emails Greiner saying God wants him to build a 77'7" cross over IH 10 for God's Glory.

Greiner meets Clifford Reeh owner of 23 acres on IH-10. Greiner learned Reeh was a Christian and one of his art collectors!

19 Prayer Intercessors pray for the \$500,000 needed to acquire land owned by Clifford Reeh. Scorpion & hawks appear as "signs".

Resistance from atheists & others ignited after a positive newspaper article on the Garden by the Kerrville Daily Times.

A lawsuit was filed by opponents to stop the cross from being erected on its \$100,000 concrete foundation.

Victory in the lawsuit that attempted to stop the 77'7" \$2,000,000 cross from being raised in Garden.

"The Empty Cross" is erected as hundreds watch. Shekinah Glory Dust & Angel Orbs appear to dozens of witnesses and are photographed.

Dr. Mahesh Chavda, a stranger, calls Max & Sherry Greiner out of a congregation in Austin, TX and proclaims the Greiners will help restore the Tabernacle. (Isa 2:2 & Amos 9:11)

God reveals the land for the Garden to Greiner saying: "Look up, this is the land I will give you."

TCKF was formed on 5/6/04 as a non-profit 501c3 art museum with seven founding Trustees: Max & Sherry Greiner, Rebecca Jons, Jack Rothenflue, David Danielson, Nancy & Randy Scroggins.

Contractor, Basil McKay starts work on Garden, but is stopped by neighbors opposed to the Cross & Garden.

Contractor, Basil McKay reports that snakes are leaving the Garden property. Eight days later he reports that a pure white dove descended in front of their operating heavy equipment.

Cross is secretly transported to the Garden, but must remain on the ground due to the 15 month lawsuit's Restraining Order.

Kerrville's 1956 "Centennial Plate" is discovered, which depicts a giant hollow cross on a hill in Kerrville, foreshadowing "The Empty Cross"

Public access to the cross opens with the first Easter Sunrise Service held at the Sculpture Prayer Garden.
