Hanukkah on the Mountain!

A sunset "Prayer for the City" event, organized by TCKF Committee Chairman, Jim McKnight, was held at the **Sculpture Prayer Garden** construction site in Kerrville, Texas on December 4, 2007. It simultaneously marked the precise beginning of **Hanukkah** around the world, which celebrates the rededication of the ancient Jewish Temple in Jerusalem. We believe the **Sculpture Prayer Gardens** are a "type" of modern day Tabernacle (Amos 9:11-12 & Isaiah 2:2-3).

The joyous, event included 25 Christians who gathered to pray for the city and over the garden property. Other area pastors in attendance included David Danielson, Jack Rothenflue and Robby Carpenter.

The wondrous presence of the Lord was evident to everyone. Numerous flash photographs taken after the prayer time revealed many unusual Angelic Orbs floating over the prayer intercessors, as described in the Bible in Ezekiel 1:15-22. Amazing!
