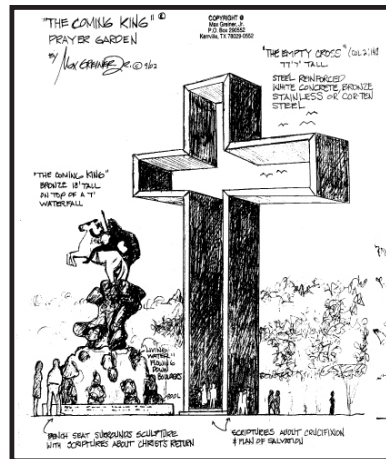
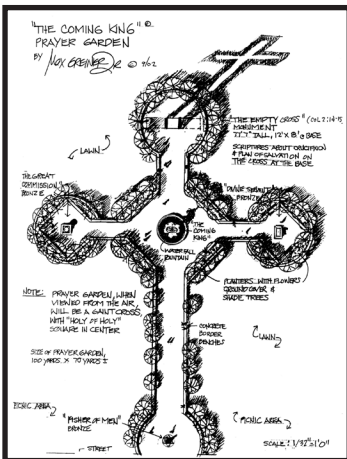

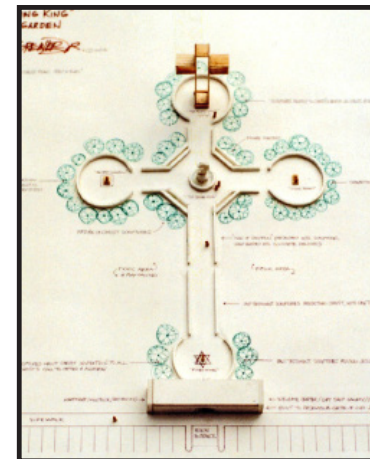


On August 22, 2002, stranger, Marlon Quibodeaux emailed artist, Max Greiner Jr., stating that God wanted him to build a 77'7" Resurrection cross sculpture to be erected over IH-10 in Texas.

On August 22, 2002, artist, architect, evangelist Max Greiner Jr. prayed about Marlon Quibodeaux's strange prophecy and received a detailed vision from God of a Sculpture Prayer Garden.

After creating rough sketches of his vision, Greiner built scale models of a 300' cross-shaped garden and a unique 77'7" cor-ten steel sculpture, which he named “The Empty Cross”.
